

Your child receives personal coaching on how to achieve extraordinary goals in their chosen domains of excellence while learning essential academic and personal skills.





A typical day for a novice



Community

Check in with each other, present their work and show appreciation.

Architectonics

Create stories inspired by the Five Great Lessons of Montessori.

Socratic

Use debate skills to solve mathematical problems, sort through complex texts and address ethical issues.

Lunch

Eat lunch, bond with nature, share poems, go on scavenger hunts and even do culinary activities.

Offline Learning

Pursue various art projects, including drawing, sculpting, cooking and writing or performing music.

Projects

Individual and in groups, led by guides with assistance from TSE Middle School apprentices.

Council

Intently listen and speak, becoming more understanding and gaining a sense that all students are equals.

Advisory Sessions

Check in with their advisors and discuss progress on attaining goals.

A typical day for a middle & high school student



Community

An informal guide-led conversation to start the day socially, much as they would in an in-person school.

Personal Growth

The guide sets a topic about big picture or personal issues, to discuss how to live a better, happier life.

Projects

Each student is expected to do a personal project based on their own interests, while being coached.

Socratic

A discussion on a complex text, classic or contemporary, similar to the work required on the SAT verbal exam.

Writing

Work on essay topics of their own choosing based on the intellectual dialogue they just had in the Socratic discussion.

Science

From standard classes such as Biology, Chemistry, or Physics as well as cool science options such as the Science of Video Games, Optimizing the Human Body, and Java Development.

Lunch

Students have an hour off for lunch. They are encouraged to get off the computer and engage in some movement.

Math

Work through self-paced adaptive math curricula suitable to their level and ability, while being guided.

Electives

Electives include Art, Music, Video Production, Graphic Design, Audio Engineering, Spanish, Debate, U.S. History, World History, Fitness, and more. TESTIMONIALS
